MSC Mammoth: These large-scale events encompass a broad range of activities involving 75 to 300 volunteers occur over the course of four to six blockbuster days.

MSC Mini: These smaller events focus on a tighter geographic area to accomplish specific trail improvements and accommodate up to 30 people per day. These projects ask you to be more self-supported and offer the opportunity to interact more closely with local and statewide volunteers in a cohesive environment.

Training: Reflects focused skill-building opportunities built into the Mobile Skills Crew event.

May 17-21 (Wed-Sun)	Ringle Segment, Marathon County	Begin construction on 1.7 miles of NEW trail. A reimagining of the Ringle Segment begins in earnest in 2017. This 1.7 mile section is the first step in a 6.7 mile project
May 31- June 2 (Wed-Fri)	Eagle Segment, Waukesha County	The IATA built over 1,400 feet of boardwalk in 2016. Learn hands-on boardwalk layout and construction training to help build the next 1,400 feet

June 1-3 (Thurs-Sat)	Blue Hills Storm Damage Clean Up	Experienced Sawyers and Signers Wanted!! Chainsaw, trail signage, and clearing work to clean up 2016 storm damage
June 22-25 (Thurs-Sun)	IAT-U, Merrill School Forest, Lincoln Co.	Learn new and enhance existing skills. The educational portion will be coupled with work to construct a new boardwalk. Check website for more details and course offerings.
July 11-13 (Tue-Thurs)	Farm Tech Days Kewaunee County	Raise dollars for the IATA by serving good grub at Farm Technology Days or help open a NEW trail segment in the charming city of Algoma
July 26-29 (Wed-Sat)	Lake 11 Segment, Taylor County	Replace an old bridge and construct a new one in the Chequamegon National Forest; keep an eye out for unannounced satellite projects also!!!
Aug 9-13 (Wed-Sun)	Ringle Segment, Marathon County	Open 1.7 miles of NEW trail for business and help prime the canvas of an additional 5 miles of new trail to follow in 2018
