

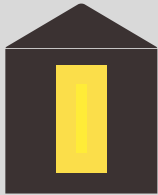
# Ice Age Trail Bingo



## HOW MANY TRAIL EXPERIENCES CAN YOU GET?

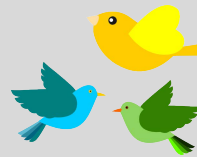

Blaze



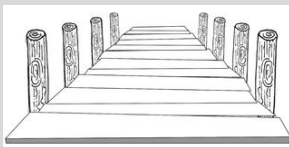
Spot an animal
