## WHERE TO HIKE IN MARQUETTE COUNTY

To earn your patch, you need to hike from the Marquette-Waushara County line to the Marquette-Columbia County line.



## This includes:

John Muir Segment—1.8 miles (from John Muir County Park lot to the parking lot on County Highway F).

Connecting Route—approximately 38 miles. Follow the suggested route or your own alternative route. Just make sure you hike the entire length of the County.
