## Ice Age Trail Communities

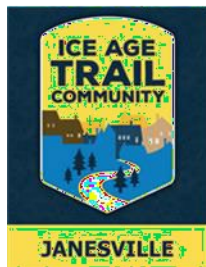
The Ice Age Trail Alliance has established the Ice Age Trail Community program, designed to help communities leverage the Trail as an economic and social engine, while promoting the Ice Age National Scenic Trail to community members and visitors alike.

Community commitment to this program represents an agreement to cross promote one another, building healthy and vibrant communities.

Janesville and Milton are the two Trail Communities in Rock County.

To be selected as a Trail Community they met the following criteria:

- community support for the Ice Age Trail and the Ice Age Trail Alliance is evident
- language for the protection of the Ice Age Trail is included in local land use plans
- involvement with the Ice Age Trail Alliance in a Saunters program, and
- a willingness to host volunteer-based events with the local chapter such as hikes and trail improvement
