<b>Aug 20 - 23</b>	<b>LaBudde Creek Segment, Sheboygan County</b>	This event carries forward and extends the geographic reach of our pre-Covid-19 MSC plans. Trail work includes 150 feet of new boardwalk, tread maintenance, signage upgrades, and Trail design and layout. Project support availability will be announced closer to the event.
<b>Sept 17-20</b>	<b>West Bend Segment, Washington County</b>	This event ranges wide to include the West Bend, Kewaskum and Holy Hill segments. Goals include new boardwalk construction, building new and improving existing trail. Project support availability will be announced closer to the event.
<b>Oct 5-11</b>	<b>Ringle Segment, Marathon County</b>	This event continues new trail construction in the heart of the reimagined Ringle Segment.
